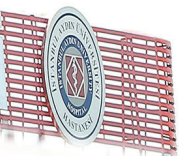

Which Documents You Need to Submit Online?

For students who are interested in Associate and Undergraduate Degree:

- High school diploma (a copy translated to Turkish or English)
- High school transcript (a copy translated to Turkish or English)
- A copy of all the grades of high school's transcripts.
- Photocopy of the relevant pages of your passport
- 60 % marks (min) in High School
- For English degree program applicants: TOEFL score - 79 points / PTE (55) (If English is not the first/ official language of the country). If students do not have TOEFL then he/ she has to pass English Proficiency Exam, which will be held in IAU. Dates will be mentioned at <http://int.aydin.edu.tr> .
- For Turkish degree program applicants: TÖMER B1 level

For Dentistry and Medicine program applicants, TÖMER C1 level.

- 1 Biometric Photograph.

For students who are interested in Master Degree:

- Undergraduate diploma (a copy translated to Turkish or English)
- Undergraduate transcript (a copy translated to Turkish or English)
- Photocopy of the relevant pages of your passport
- A cumulative GPA of 2,5 (on a 4,0) or equivalent
- For English degree program applicants: TOEFL score - 66 points or YDS/YÖKDİL score - 55 points / PTE (60) (If English is not the first/official language of the country). If students do not have TOEFL or YDS/YÖKDİL or PTE then they have to pass English Proficiency Exam, which will be held in IAU. Dates will be mentioned at <http://int.aydin.edu.tr> .
- Students applying for Turkish Degree program (TÖMER B2 Level)
- If you know Turkish (You can pass a Turkish Proficiency Exam)
- If you do not know Turkish then Apply for Turkish Language Program first at tomer.aydin.edu.tr, as without having Turkish Language visa students will not be registered to TÖMER.

For students who are interested in PhD degree:

- Undergraduate and graduate diploma (if not in English, a copy translated to Turkish or English)
- Undergraduate and graduate transcript (if not in English, a copy translated to Turkish or English)
- Photocopy of the relevant pages of your passport
- Language proficiency score in one of these languages: English, French or German.
- TOEFL IBT (84) or YDS/YÖKDİL (70) or PTE (65) if medium of instruction of degree is English.
- TOEFL IBT (66), YDS/YÖKDİL (55) or PTE (55) + TÖMER C1 if medium of instruction of degree is Turkish.
- 1 Biometric Photograph
- 2 Reference Letters
- 1 Motivation Letter + PhD Proposal
- Student's Curriculum Vitae (CV)

Students who fail passing the English proficiency exam, they have to study at preparation school of English or Turkish for a year.



Payment

In order to complete online application students should pay 100 USD application fee. After the completion of the evaluation student will be notified for tuition fee. To receive the “Acceptance Letter” all students will have to pay first year’s tuition fee and/or the first installment of it. (In some case you would be requested to pay all tuition fee, which depends on Embassy Regulations of Countries)

Please be aware that tuition fee payment doesn't mean that quota is reserved.

How to get visa?

After submitting your online application form and getting accepted to study in IAU, you will receive an Acceptance Letter and then contact the nearest Turkish Embassy in your country for details regarding visa process.

Students who are coming from countries which do not need visa to enter Turkey, do not need to get the student visa as well.



Documents Needed Before Registration

➔ For students who are under 18 years old:

If the student is under 18 years old, a Birth Certificate & the student's Parents Travelling Approval (Where it has to be mentioned that the student is allowed to study in IAU) are required. The Apostille of these documents have to be translated to Turkish and Approved by the Turkish Embassy in the student's country.

➔ Apostille/Attestation

If the applicants completed their education out of Turkey, An Apostille/Attestation of the Diploma & Transcript are needed. For the countries which their documents need apostille, please click on the link below:

For other countries, an Attestation from the ministry of foreign affairs of the student's country is required.

Documents Required to Finalize the Registration:

For students who are interested in Associate and Bachelor Degree

➔ Acceptance Letter received from Istanbul Aydin University

➔ Turkish translation of High school diploma and transcript

➔ Notarization of translated High school diploma and transcript from Notary in Turkey or Turkish Embassy in your country

➔ The original copy of all the grades of high school's transcripts.

➔ Health Insurance for one year (compulsory – You will make your insurance paperwork in J Block with International Students Office.

➔ Equivalency Paper (Denklik Belgesi) of High school diploma from Provincial Directorate of Ministry of Education in Istanbul (You can obtain this document from the Turkish embassy in your country, or if you won't be able to obtain it in your country, once you arrive in Turkey you can apply for it from the Turkish Ministry of Education's website

➔ Language proficiency certificate

▶ For English degree program applicants: TOEFL-IBT -79 points / PTE (55) (if English is not first/ official language of the country). If students do not have TOEFL then he/ she has to pass English Proficiency Exam, which will be held in Istanbul Aydin University. Dates will be mentioned at **<http://int.aydin.edu.tr>**

▶ For Turkish degree program applicants: TOMER score – B1 level

▶ For Dentistry and Medicine program applicants, TÖMER C1 level.

For students who are interested in Master Degree

➔ Acceptance Letter received from Istanbul Aydin University

➔ Turkish translation of Undergraduate diploma and transcript

➔ Notarization of translated Undergraduate diploma and transcript from Notary in Turkey or Turkish Embassy in your country

➔ Health Insurance for one year (compulsory– You will make your insurance paperwork in J Block with International Students Office.

➔ Language proficiency certificate:

▶ For English degree program applicants: TOEFL score - 66 points or YDS/YÖKDİL score - 55 points / PTE (60) (If English is not the first/official language of the country). If students do not have TOEFL or YDS/YÖKDİL then they have to pass English Proficiency Exam, which will be held in IAU. Dates will be mentioned at **<https://int.aydin.edu.tr>** .

▶ For Turkish degree program applicants: TÖMER B2 level (For Health Sciences, TÖMER C1 is required)

▶ For applications for the Institute of Health Sciences Programs, an Equivalency Document (Denklik Belgesi) is required.

Students who fail passing the English proficiency exam, they have to study at preparation school of English or Turkish for a year.

► Registrations for Turkish Programs, TOMER B2 Certificate is required (For Health Sciences, TÖMER C1 is required), if the student doesn't have the Turkish language certificate, Turkish Preparatory school (TÖMER) registration will be done. Turkish Preparatory fee + first instalment payment is required.

► Registration for English Programs, Language Certificate (TOEFL-IBT -66 points) / PTE (60) is required, if the student doesn't have the English language certificate, English Preparatory school registration will be done. English Preparatory fee + first instalment payment is required.

For students who are interested in PhD degree

- ➔ Acceptance Letter received from Istanbul Aydin University
- ➔ Turkish translation of Bachelor and Master's diplomas and transcripts.

➔ Notarization of translated Bachelor and Master's diplomas and transcripts from Notary in Turkey or Turkish embassy in your country.

➔ Health Insurance for one year (compulsory – You will make your insurance paperwork in J Block with International Students Office).

➔ Language Proficiency Certificate

► TOEFL IBT (84) or YDS/YÖKDİL (70) or PTE (65) if medium of instruction of degree is English.

► TOEFL IBT (66), YDS/YÖKDİL (55) or PTE (55) + TÖMER C1 if medium of instruction of degree is Turkish.

➔ 1 Motivation Letter + PhD Proposal

➔ Student's Curriculum Vitae (CV)

After Registration: To Do List

⇒ Student ID

After completing the registration, the student must get their Student ID from the Department of Student Affairs Office. (T Block / Entrance Floor)

⇒ Student Letter

After acquiring the Student ID, Student Letter have to be acquired from Student Affairs Office (T Block / Ground Floor)

⇒ Course Selection

- ▶ Course Selection will be done from “ ubis.aydin.edu.tr ” website
- ▶ After finishing the course selection, a copy (three copies needed) of the selected courses will be taken and approved by the advisor
- ▶ The course program will be available after the advisor approves the course selection
- ▶ This course program will be shown on the “ ubis.aydin.edu.tr ” website

⇒ Public Transportation Card (Istanbul Transportation Card/AKBİL)

To receive the Transportation Card, the student needs to have the following documents:

⇒ Passport / Residence Permit

⇒ 1 Photograph

⇒ Student Letter

After acquiring the necessary documents, the student can go to one of the IETT Stations to do the payment and receive the Istanbul Transportation Card

➔ Bank Account

After receiving their Residence Permit, the student can open a bank account.

The necessary documents to open a bank account:

- ▶ Passport
- ▶ Residence Permit
- ▶ Student Letter
- ▶ Residence Certificate (District Population Directorate)

➔ Museum Card

Students are able to purchase a Museum Card from the closest museum

How to get residence permit?

Students need to apply for Resident Permit within 1 month after arriving in Turkey. The application for residence permit is done at the Istanbul Migration directorate. If the students don't apply for their residence permit within the first month after arrival, their visa will be cancelled by Istanbul Migration Directorate. The required documents for Residence Permit Application:

To apply for a residence permit application from the Istanbul Provincial Directorate of Migration Management, this online form must be filled:

- ▶ Online Application Form for residence permit (Obtained after filling the application form found in https://e-ikamet.goc.gov.tr)
- ▶ New Dated Student Letter (You can get this from T Block - Ground Floor after the completion of your registration).
- ▶ One-Year-Valid Health Insurance (Compulsory- You will make your insurance paperwork in J Block with International Students Office).

- ▶ Four (4) photos (biometric & white background)
- ▶ Original copy and photocopy of passport or passport substitute (First page of the passport with the picture and details, visas and other pages with any details)
- ▶ Proof regarding sufficient and sustainable resources for the duration of your stay in Turkey (Bank Statement or Financial Support Letter from the Sponsor)
- ▶ The Payment Receipt for your residence permit card

After your arrival in Turkey, please visit us at Istanbul Aydin University - International Students Office (Florya Campus, J block ground floor) and we will assist you in final registration and International Students and Staff Affairs Office will assist you with your residence permit process.

Things to Remember

▶ After receiving the acceptance letter, student can change their department before the final registration. This is only an option if the new department still can accept a new student

▶ The Letter of Acceptance, is only a formal document which shows that the student is eligible for the University and it is not a Student Letter. To be registered to any department it is important to finalize your registration, the letter of acceptance does not mean that you are registered to the department at all. When the department's quota is full, it is possible that the student can be redirected to another department.

Please be aware that tuition fee payment doesn't mean that quota is reserved.

▶ Students with a Student Visa cannot register to TOMER Programs

▶ Associate degree and Bachelor's degree applications are only available once a year in the fall intake

▶ Master's and PHD applications are available twice a year. Applications are open in the fall and the spring intakes

▶ There are three conditions for Turkish National Students that want to register for a Turkish University as International Students

1) Students have to complete their entire high school education in abroad

2) Students have to have Blue Card (Mavi Kart)

3) If Students have two citizenships and completed their high school education in Turkey, They should get a paper from their neighborhood representative's office (Muhtarlık) which states that; This person has obtained Turkish citizenship after obtaining another country's citizenship. With that document, they can register to Turkish Universities as international students.

Scholarship

Istanbul Aydin University provides scholarship opportunities for their active and successful International Students, were the student needs to attend at least 1 semester at Aydin University. To avail these opportunities, it is important that the student is active in social and cultural activities within and outside the university as well.

➔ The applications for the Fall Intake will be open from 15th March to 30th September every year.

Final registration will start from the beginning of June every year.

➔ Spring semester applications will be open from 1st November to 28th February every year. Final registration will start from December every year.
